## Ceramic Flower Craft Kit

### Instructions:

1. Take the clay out of the plastic bag and mold it into a doughnut shape. If you play with the clay too much it will dry out. Place your clay shape on your paper bag so it doesn't stick to your desk.
2. Lay out the pipe cleaners and rhinestones to decide on a pattern you want to create on the flower.
3. Use scissors to cut the pipe cleaners into small pieces. You might want to make them different sizes for different parts of your pattern.
4. Starting on the inside of the doughnut, push the pipe cleaners and rhinestones into the clay so that they stick out.
5. Next, do the same thing on the outside of the doughnut shape. You might want your longest pieces or rhinestones on the outside.
6. Fill in the rest of the clay with your pipecleaner pieces.
7. Allow the clay to dry. It will take several days.
