Tulsa, OK— 108|Contemporary is bringing Liz Whitney Quisgard's *Kinetic World* to Tulsa, Oklahoma. Hailing from New York, Quisgard is nationally recognized for her large-scale fiber works that rejoice the simplistic and mesmerizing nature of everyday geometry. Borrowing inspiration from Greek columns, Navajo textiles and Baroque architecture, Quisgard takes her audience on a journey across the world.

Once a painter, Liz Whitney Quisgard now focuses on geometric fiber art. She does not attempt to send a specific message with her work. Rather, she uses commonplace shapes like circles, squares, and triangles to create a decorative environment. Some patrons may attend galleries to discover meaning while Quisgard simply wants her audience to be entranced by the meticulous detail found in every shape. Her pieces range from canvas-like portraits to installations that cover entire walls. The repetitive geometry used in each piece trick the eye into seeing an endless loop of pattern and color.
