On view February 6 - March 21, 2026 this exhibition features wall hung and installation works that abandon the weight of perfectionism for the sake of freedom in creation and environmental reflection. Join us for the exhibition opening on Friday, February 6, 2026 from 6:00 – 9:00 pm for an evening of art admiring and interacting plus a new I Spy Challenge and Craft Kit based on the exhibit.

*Roughly Right* infuses the act of turning process into ritual, repetition into meditation, and soft shadows into alternative architecture. Sitting at the intersection of drawing and sculpture, this exhibition emphasizes the importance of the handmade wavering line and the conversation between layers of paper, pattern and body.

Alicia Kelly was born and raised among the red dirt and wildflowers of Northeastern Oklahoma, but calls Kansas home. Her love of the paper medium developed alongside her love of pattern making and the screen print process. Alicia is a printmaking and paper arts instructor at The Lawrence Arts Center and a Cultural Arts Commissioner for the City of Lawrence. She is an active member of The Paper Artist Collective and Guild of American Papercutters and works out of her home studio in Lawrence, KS.
